A LYONS WISH

Within one week in March 1982, Marty Lyons, a defensive lineman for the New York Jets for 12 years, was faced with three life-altering challenges: as a father—the birth of his first son, as a son—the death of his father; and as a Big Brother—the loss of Keith to leukemia.

True to his words, and with the encouragement and support of family and friends, in December of 1982 Marty established a Foundation dedicated to granting wishes to children (ages 3 to 17) with a life-threatening or terminal illness. The philosophy behind his mission was that by promoting hope and inspiration in a sick child, they will find the courage and strength to fight their illness. What was perceived as impossible could become possible!

In 44 years, The Marty Lyons Foundation has granted over 8,800 wishes through their wish programs, and are unique in that they will consider a second wish for children who are experiencing further complications due to their illnesses. Since it's inception, over \$44 million has been raised and currently the average cost of a wish is \$7,850.

DENIS S. BARRY WAS A MAN WITH A MOST GENEROUS HEART

For more than eleven years, he was a devoted volunteer with the Marty Lyons Foundation, serving as a member of their Board of Directors. Denis gave of himself in a most unselfish way. Of the many life lessons he taught those around him, perhaps the most important one was suggesting we make room in our lives to help others who are less fortunate.

When Denis passed away in December of 2004, his family and friends vowed to keep his name alive by founding the Denis S. Barry Foundation.

The Denis S. Barry Foundation, Inc. supports families who need financial assistance in order to provide a proper burial for a child who has died as a result of their illness. The Foundation partners exclusively with the Marty Lyons Foundation to help wish families in their time of need. In the past 22 years, the DBF have helped provide dignified burials for over 80 children.

ABOUT OUR HONOREE

John Cronin has spent his adult life building a business, advocating for others, and proving what people with differing abilities can do. As a young man with Down syndrome, John says, "Down syndrome never holds me back." John is the co-founder of John's Crazy Socks, where he has created jobs for people with differing abilities, donated more than \$850,000 to charitable causes, including Special Olympics New York and the National Down Syndrome Society, and shipped happiness to customers in 94 countries. A Forbes 30 Under 30 honoree, EY Entrepreneur of the Year, and Special Olympics athlete, John has testified before the U.S. Congress and spoken at the United Nations. He's long been a supporter of the Marty Lyons Foundation and is active in his hometown community of Huntington.
